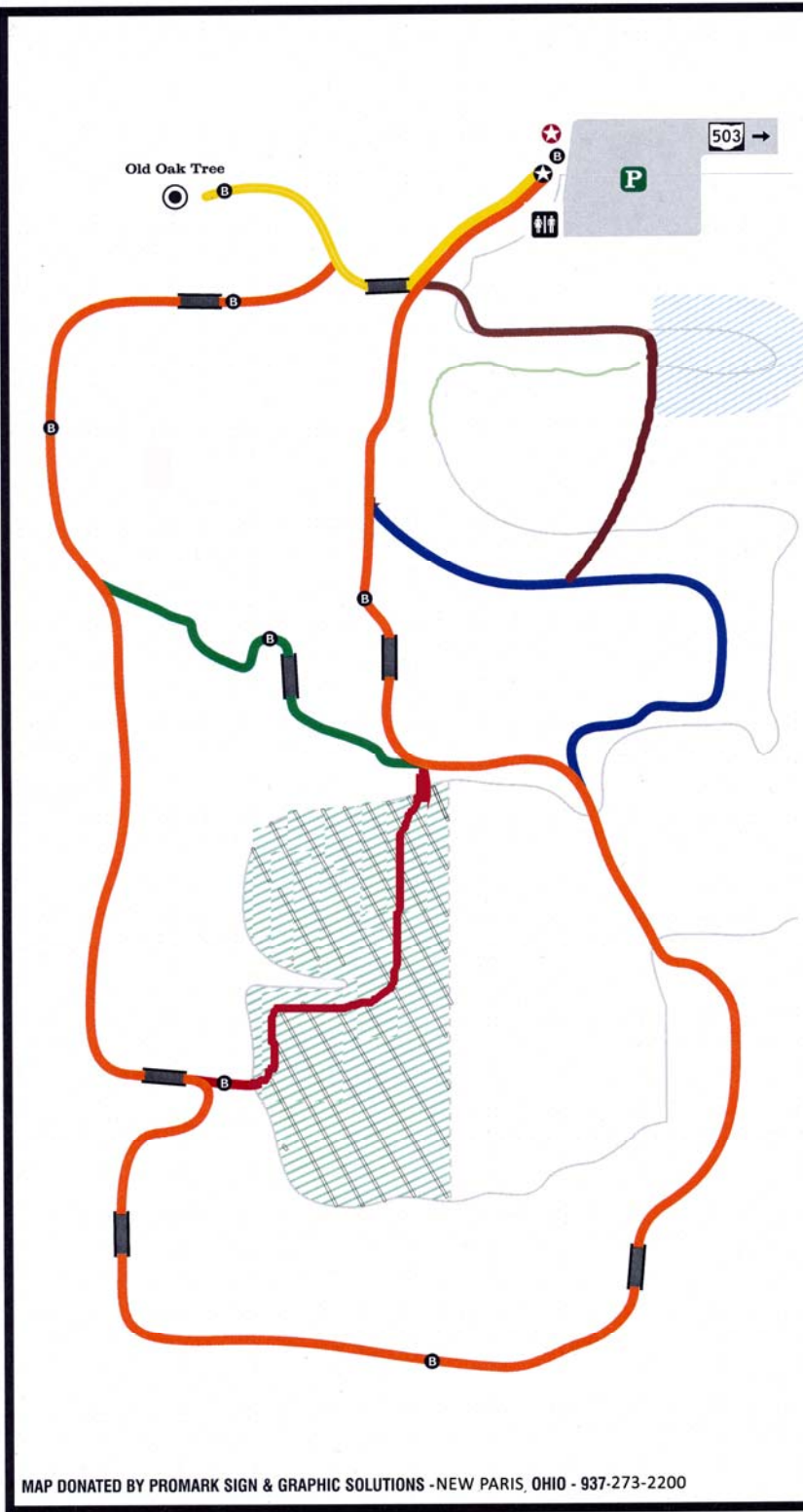

**Nature Center Regulations**

- Do not pick, collect, or disturb plant or animal materials of any kind.
- Hikers must remain on the designated trails.
- Trails may have loose rocks, thorny plants and large tree roots. These natural conditions may be challenging for strollers & wheelchairs.
- Motorized vehicles (including ATVs) must remain on Nature Center roads; parking is permitted in designated parking areas only.
- PETS - Dogs allowed on leashes only. Leashes may be no longer than 8 feet. Dog droppings must be removed from trails.
- ALCOHOL - Not permitted.
- Bicycles - Not permitted on trails.
- Nature Center hours: Dawn to Dusk
